


**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Mark only with a writing instrument provided by the board of elections.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot fill in the oval  in the upper right corner of the box containing the name of the candidate.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot write or stamp his or her name in the box labeled "write-in" that appears at the bottom of the column for such office.
4. To vote "yes" or "no" on a proposal, if any, that appears on the back of the ballot, fill in the oval that corresponds to your vote.
5. Any other mark, or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or "write-in" box provided for voting will void this entire ballot.
6. Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office, party position, or proposal.
7. If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Elections at (315)366-2231 or boecommissioners@co.madison.ny.us for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon the return of the original ballot.
8. Enclose the voted ballot in the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections, fill in all information in the voter's statement on the back of the envelope, and sign your name where indicated.
9. Mail immediately.
10. The ballot of the voter must be postmarked no later than November 7, 2011 and received by the Board of Elections no later than November 15, 2011.
11. The ballot of the Military voter must be postmarked no later than November 7, 2011 and received no later than November 21, 2011.
