**AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO SIGN THE HOME RULE REQUESTING THE STATE ENACT LEGISLATION TO ALLOW MADISON COUNTY TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL MORTGAGE RECORDING TAX OF TWENTY-FIVE CENTS PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF DEBT**

**WHEREAS**, the State Legislature requires a home rule request prior to passing any local legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Legislature requires passage of the local resolution authorizing issuance of a home rule request after the Bill has been introduced in the Legislature each session year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed and studied the issues and finds that imposing an additional mortgage recording tax of twenty-five cents per one hundred dollars of debt to apply to Emergency Communications System Upgrade Project debt payments is in the best interests of the residents of Madison County; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the State legislation, S7983 and A11327 to implement the additional mortgage recording tax is on file with the Clerk;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes and requests the State Legislature enact Senate bill S7983 and Assembly bill A11327 as on file with the Clerk of this Board; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to sign the Home Rule Requests required to enact Senate bill S7983 and Assembly bill A11327.
