

## **Special Delinquency Prevention Program (SDPP) Funds**

SDPP funds are designated for programs that serve "targeted youth" with well defined needs and that provide for at least one of the priorities identified by the Office for Children & Family Services. These funds reimburse up to 100% of approved program costs. No match is required.

The following programs/agencies were awarded SDPP funding by the Madison County Youth Bureau and Youth Board to provided services, opportunities and supports for targeted children & youth in Madison County in 2010:

**Youth Intervention & Support Services Program - \$18,225.00** - Operated by [Liberty Resources](#). The Youth Intervention & Support Services program provides direct intervention and prevention services for youth between the ages of 13 - 20 years old who are experiencing heightened problems with family and/or peers, school issues, behavioral concerns, emotional challenges, abuse/neglect issues, or face dangers or potential dangers that will affect their health and development. Services include information and referral, short-term intervention services and supportive case management services. For more information call 363-0048.

**Youth Recognition Award Program – \$2,051.00** - Operated by the [Madison County Sheriff's Department](#). This program provides recognition and awards to Madison County youth that have overcome major obstacles in their lives and have started to turn their lives around. **Youth Counseling Services – \$4,000.00** - Operated by the [Jim Marshall Farms Foundation](#). This program provides mental health counseling services for youth between the ages of 7 - 20 years old in a therapeutic, rural setting. The first 5 counseling sessions are provided free of charge. Following these initial visits the youth may continue on a self-pay or other negotiated basis or be referred to other appropriate therapists or mental health service providers.
